The Liturgical Calendar shows the cycle of liturgical seasons in the Church. It determines when feast days are to be observed, and which parts of Scripture are to be read. The seasons recall and celebrate various events in the life of Christ, and are marked by distinct liturgical colors. The Church adopts a three-year cycle of readings for Sundays - Years A, B and C.

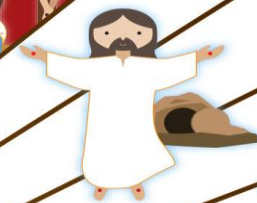

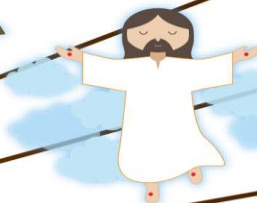

The children have been designing their own lessons during collective worship based around giving back. Their overall Theme was CAFOD. Two teams got to present and bring the children together through prayer and meditation.

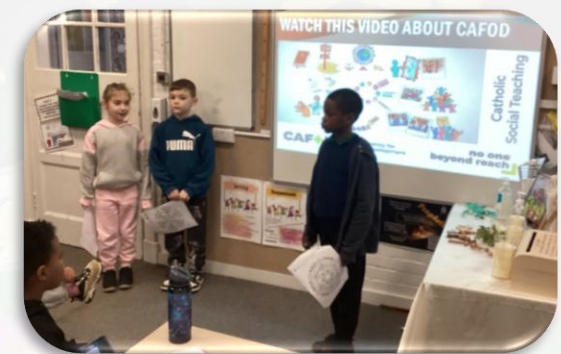


Prayer buddies

It was amazing to see the children come together and reflect upon all that we have because of our faith.

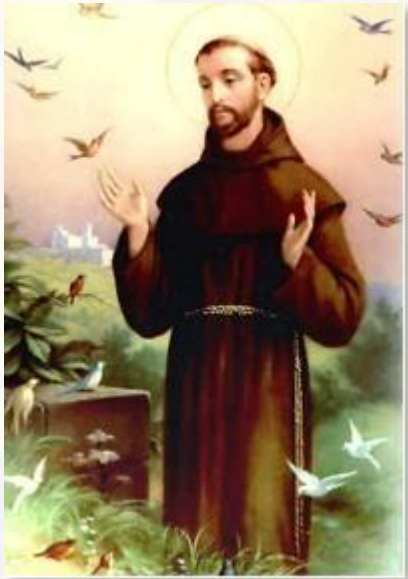


Learning and Growing as the People of God

The children explored why the crib is an important religious symbol for Christians today.



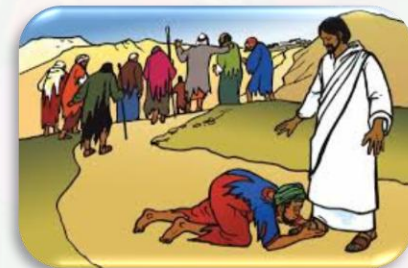
St Francis of Assisi

Asking God to bless something or someone that is important to you.



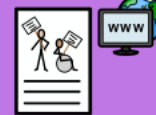
Adoration
