The children have done some amazing work on this topic and have shown great understanding in being prepared for Jesus. We have opened our hearts and welcome in the love of Jesus.



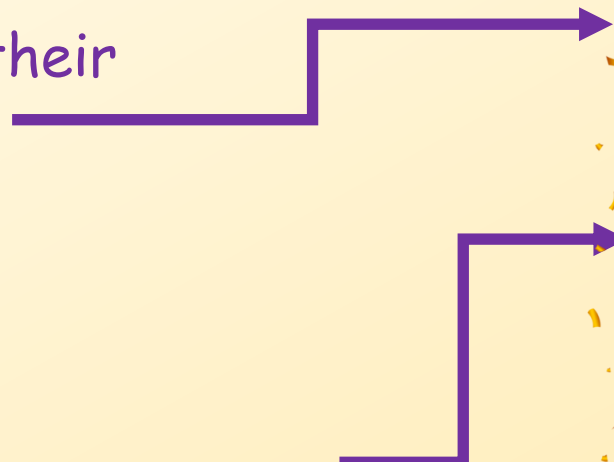
Catholic Virtues
