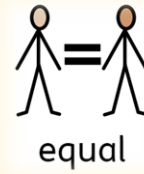
# Prayer and Liturgy

God wanted people to work together for the common good. We explored the art of collaboration through our computing lessons and understood how computers have enabled us to stay connected quickly, whilst also working together.

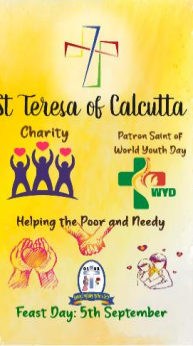
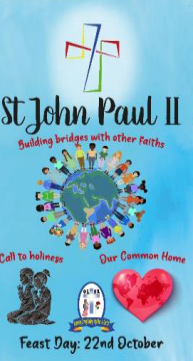
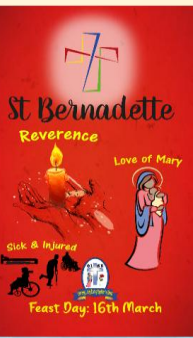
