We acted out and sequenced the Christmas Story using masks, props and small world characters.



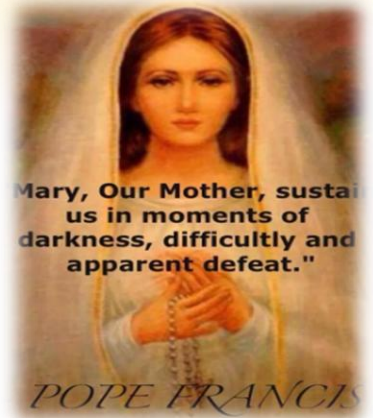
We thought about all the things that our mothers do for us, like Mary did for Jesus. We created a whole class mural of Mary to display on our prayer table.

Christmas Mary

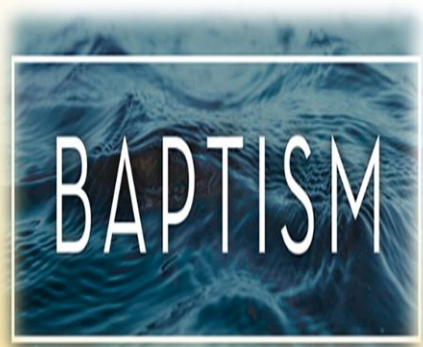


Learning and Growing as the People of God:

The children were very respectful during our trip around the school looking at the stations of the cross and really did us proud!

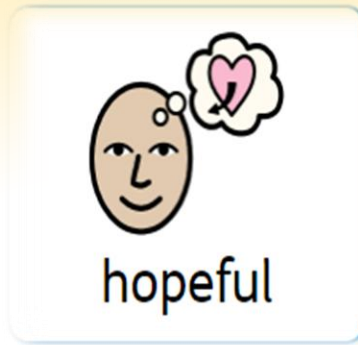
Catholic Virtues

- are enthusiastic about learning new things in school..

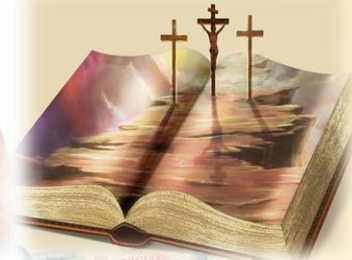

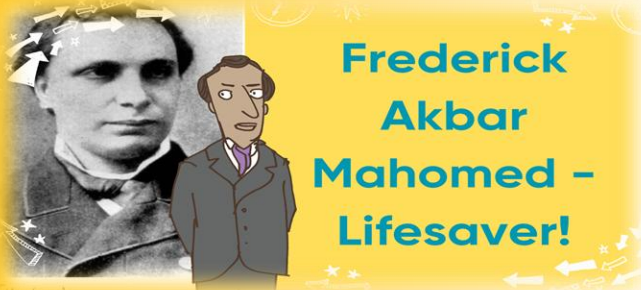
In Nursery we are **faith-filled** when we:

World Book Day

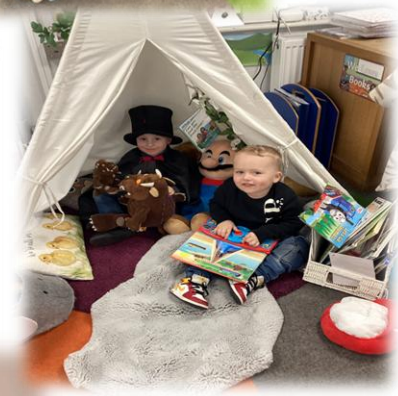
In Week 3 we celebrated World Book Day where Nursery had to dress up as magicians or magical people from books.
