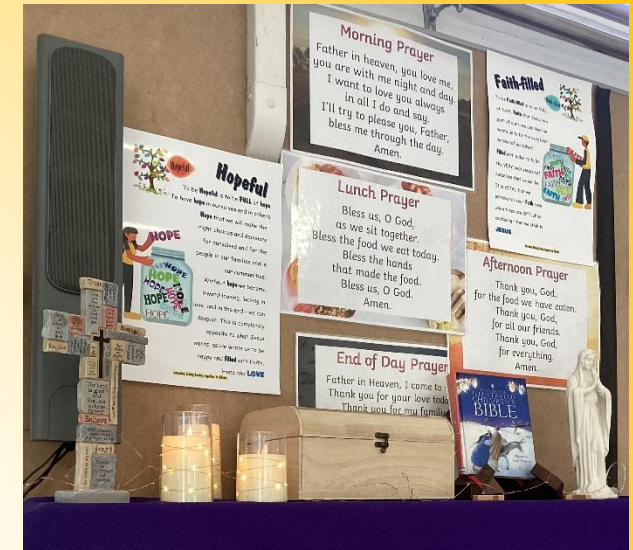
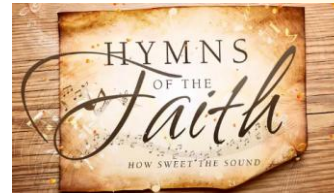


Collective Worship

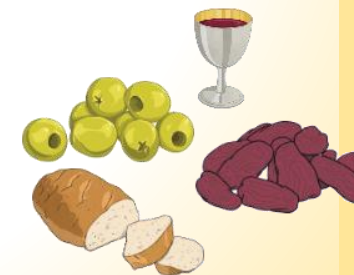
Maundy Thursday / The Last Supper
