

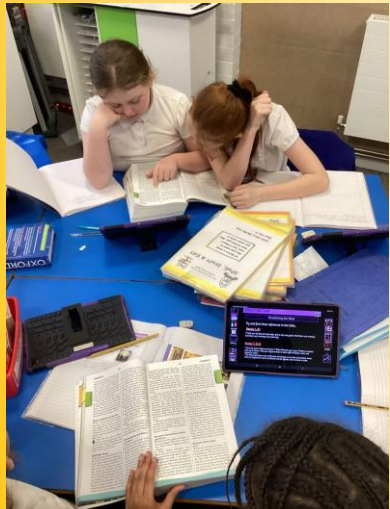


# Year 4 Faith Journey

We also prayed along with the CAFOD Holy Week prayer calendar, and took time out of each day for reflection.

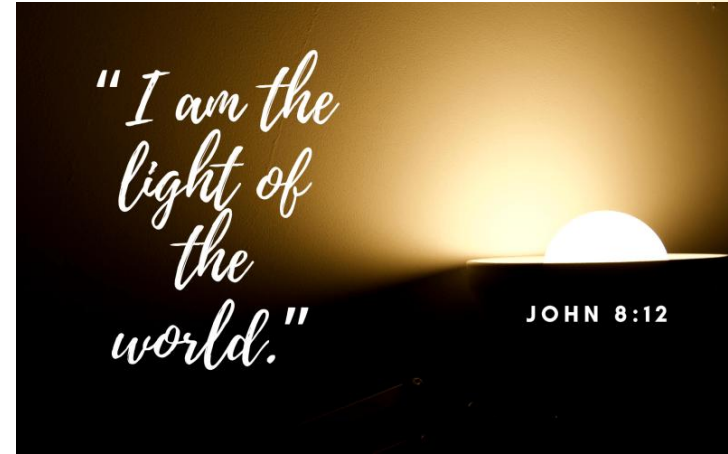

# Learning and Growing as the People of God: Prayer and Holy Week

In Spring 2 we looked at how to read Bible references, and during Holy Week we focused on the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. The class compared the Gospels, and did some excellent pieces of drama based around the different accounts of Palm Sunday.

"We are hopeful when we pray for an end to war in Mass"
