## Prayer and Liturgy in class

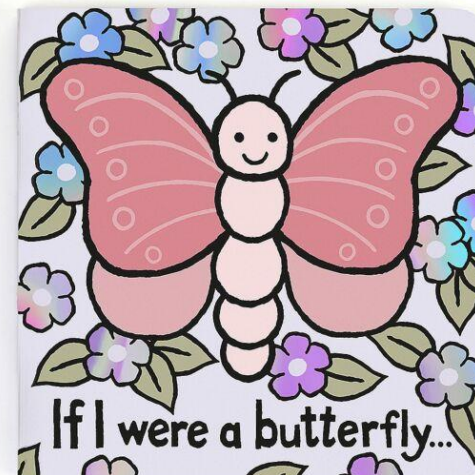
We have enjoyed reading Bible stories, singing Bible songs, having time to wonder about our faith, prayer time and Hymn practice.

## Hymn practice

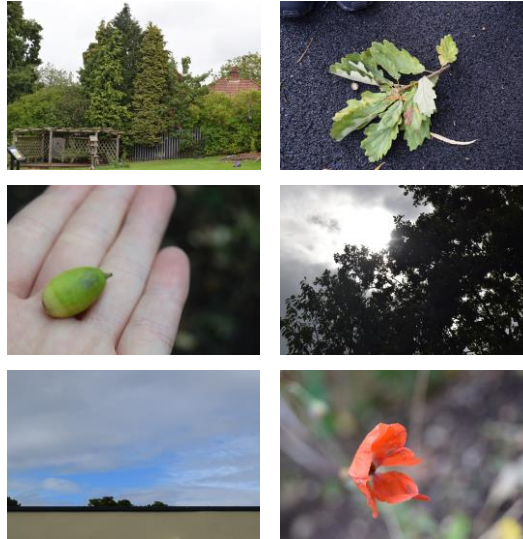
We have enjoyed joining the whole school for Hymn practice. Reception have liked learning new songs and singing them at church too.

We have been learning how to make the sign of the cross and we have talked about why and when we say it. We have also talked about the importance of the prayer table in the classroom.



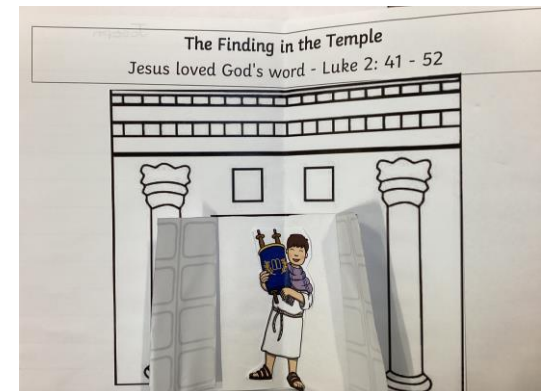

- are always kind to everyone.

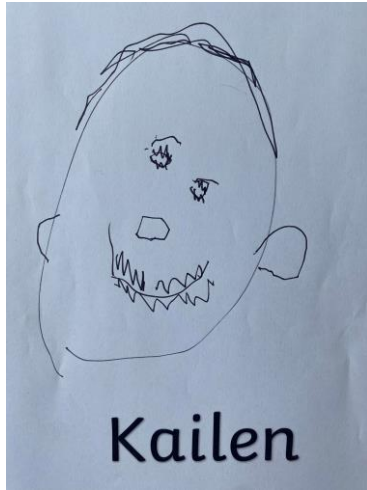
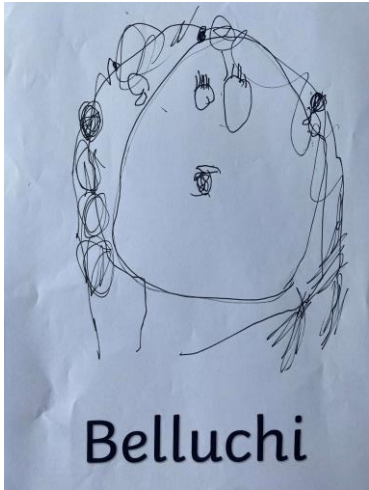


We are **curious** about and **grateful** for God's creation. We are **attentive**, **wise** and **active** in caring for our environment and God's creatures.

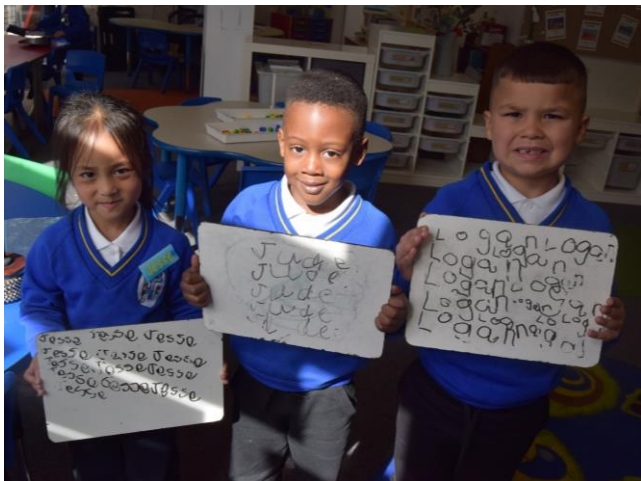
