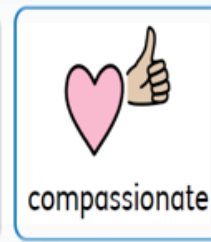
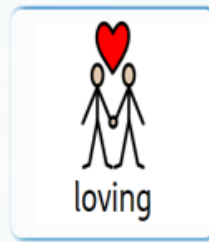
## Baptism
