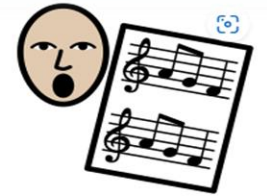


# Prayer and Liturgy

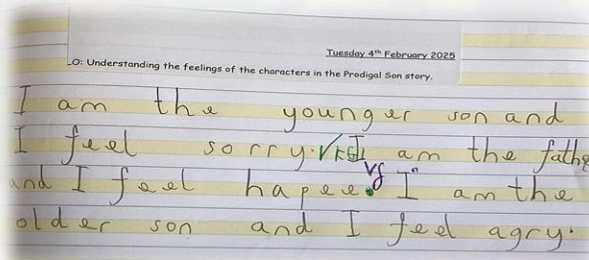
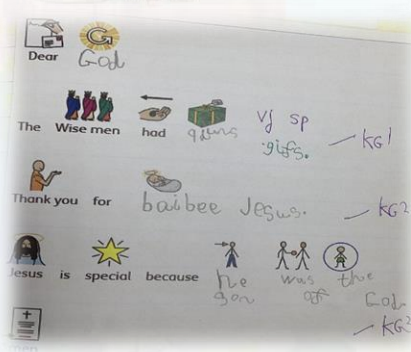
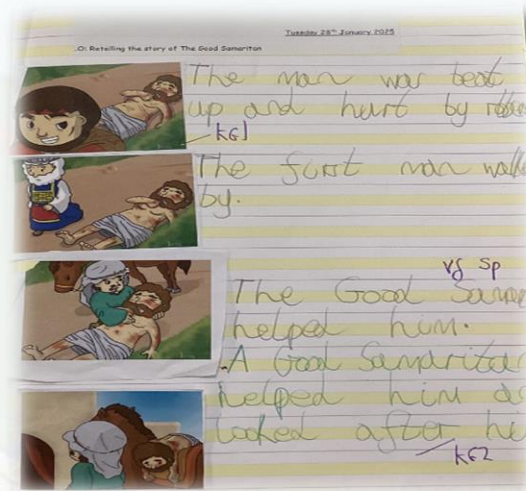
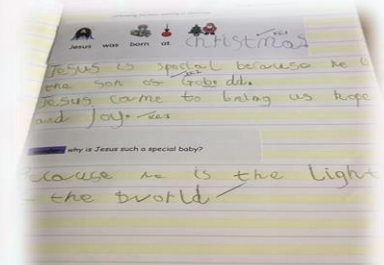
## Christmas

We also explored Epiphany and learnt about the Three Kings appearing at the stable.

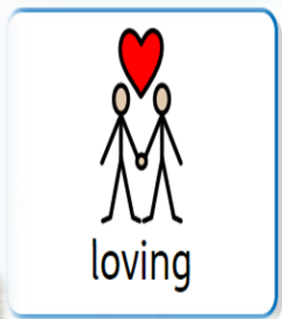
The Lost Sheep and Good Samaritan have wonderful message for us of what is important to us in our lives.

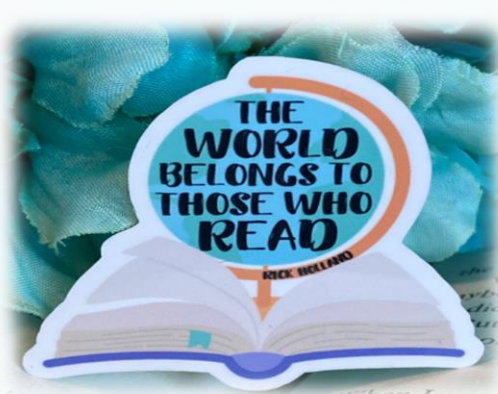


In Year 1 we are **compassionate** when we:
