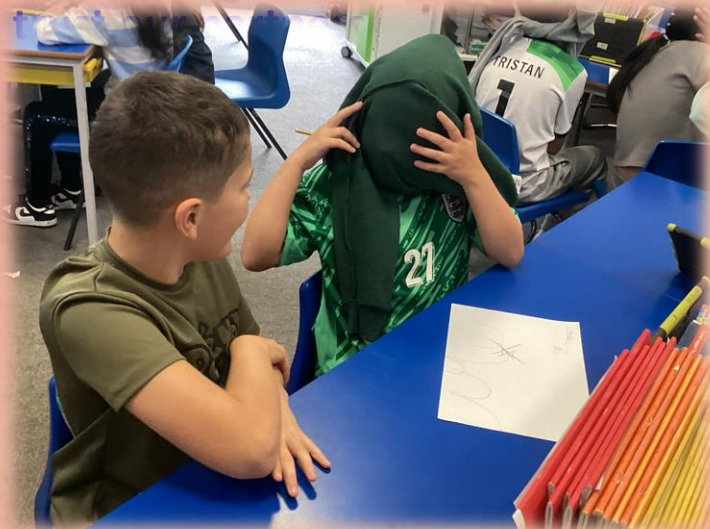
Prayer and Liturgy

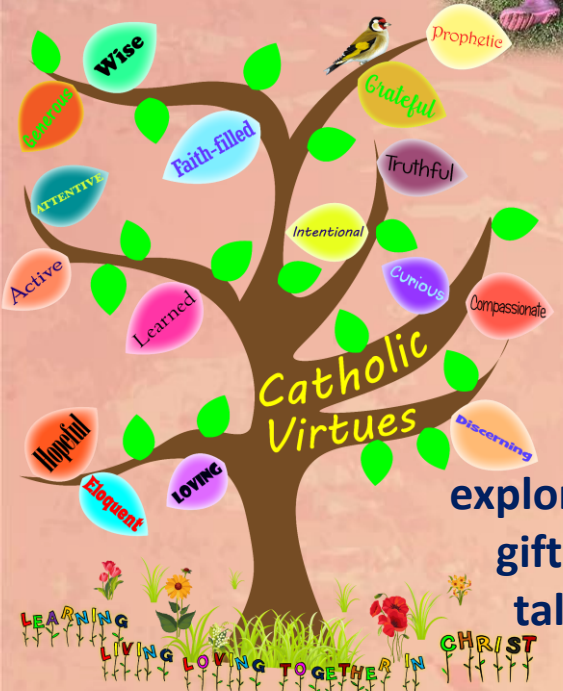

In Year 6, we are active when we...

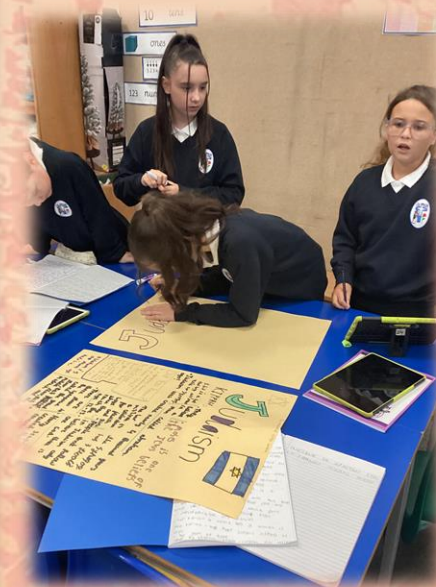
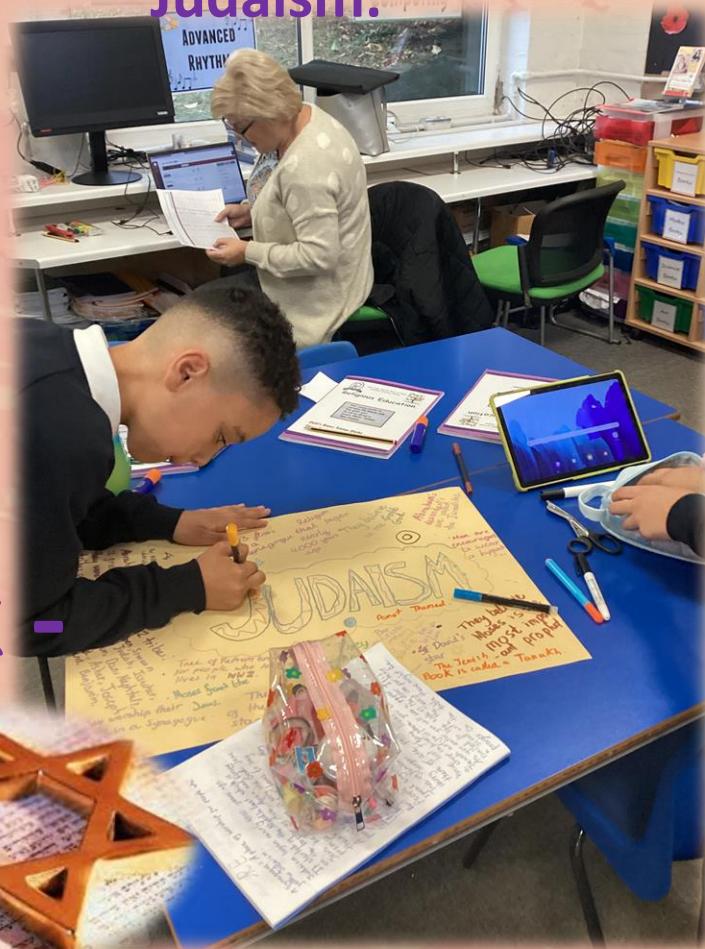
- Use our curious findings in our work when we add extra detail and information to our writing pieces

We considered how we can be good stewards to the earth with the used litter picking and planting produce to be used for cooking and to make the environment look beautiful just as God intends.

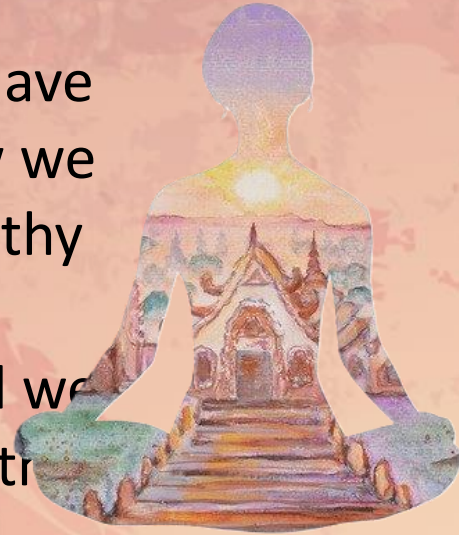
