# Ambassador's Assembly

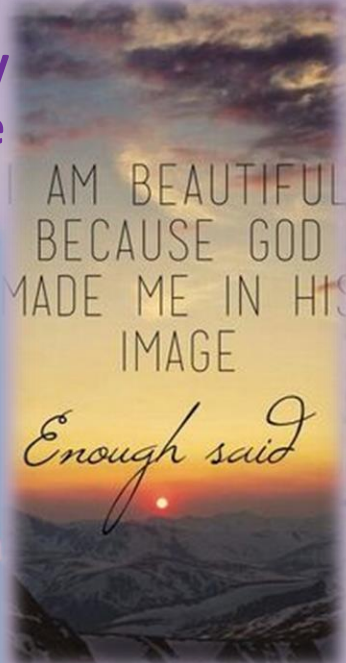
During RHSE, we have been looking at how we are all made in the image of God and how we should all respect each other including ourselves.

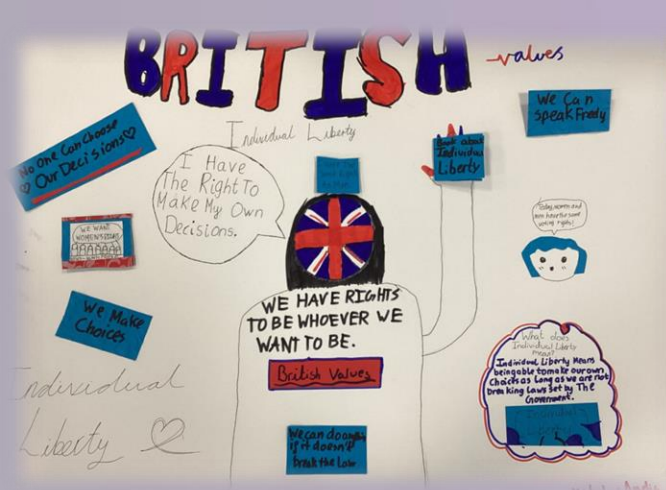

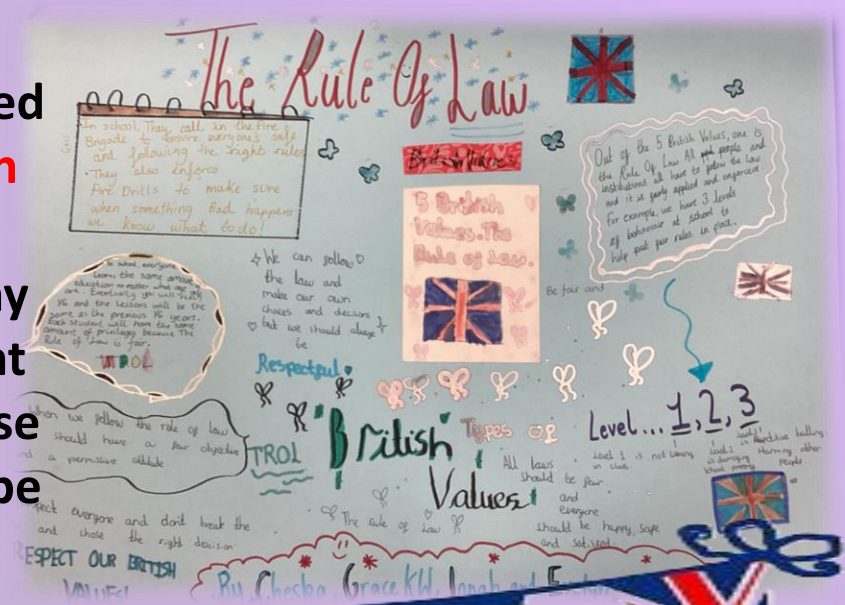
