



Good morning,

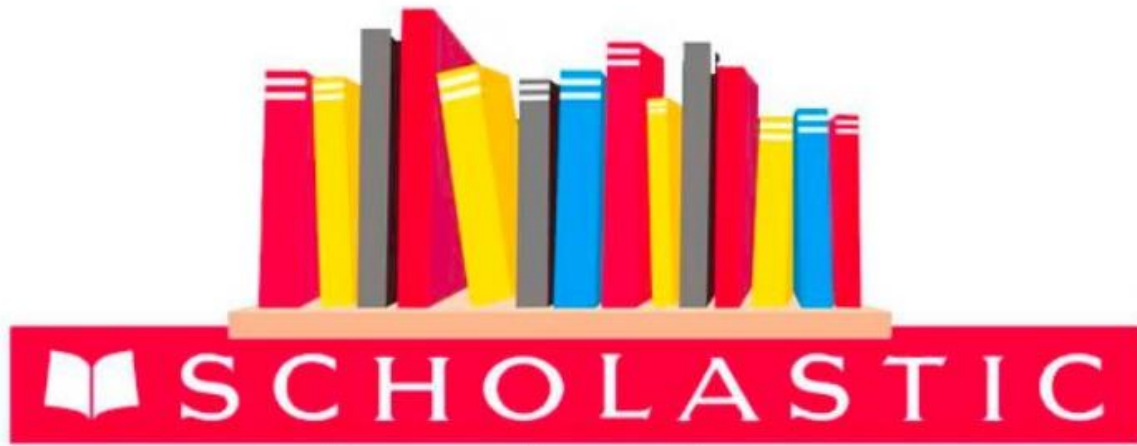
